Lieutenant Colonel Dill deployed to the following Operations: Just Cause, Desert Shield / Desert Storm, Hurricane Andrew Relief, Provide Comfort, Deny Flight, Provide Promise, Joint Endeavor, Joint Guard, Joint Guardian, Enduring Freedom, I,II, III and IV and Operation Iraqi Freedom.

Lieutenant Colonel Dill accepted command of the United States Army Parachute Team in March of 2007. With more than 1,200 free fall, 100 static line jumps, and 60 jumps to his credit as Tandem Instructor, Dill is able to "air out" still another very useful skill set in his inventory, Precision Freefall Parachuting.
